<p>YEAR 9 AUTUMN TERM</p> <p>Weeks – 1-15</p> <p>5th September – 21st December 2016</p>	<p>Celebrity Icons (Drawing/Painting): Students research their favourite icon or celebrity and create a drawing (grid /transferred /freehand) that demonstrates formal elements (Line, tone, texture, shape and proportion). <p>Year 9 SUMMER TERM</p> <p>Weeks – 27-39</p> <p>17th April – 21st July 2017</p>	<p>Graffiti Art (Drawing/Stencilling/Digital): For this final project, pupils will be introduced to the history of Graffiti Art & research their favourite Street Artists. From initial drawings, pupils imaginatively develop their own Graffiti tag and expand this into stencil, print or digital outcomes.
